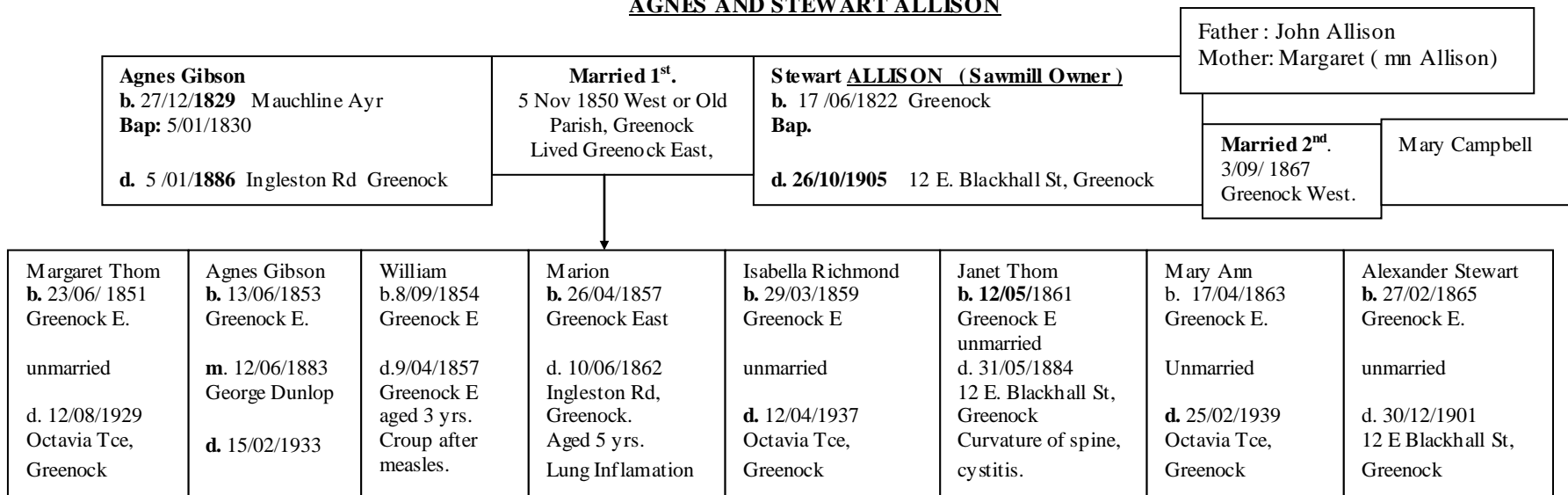

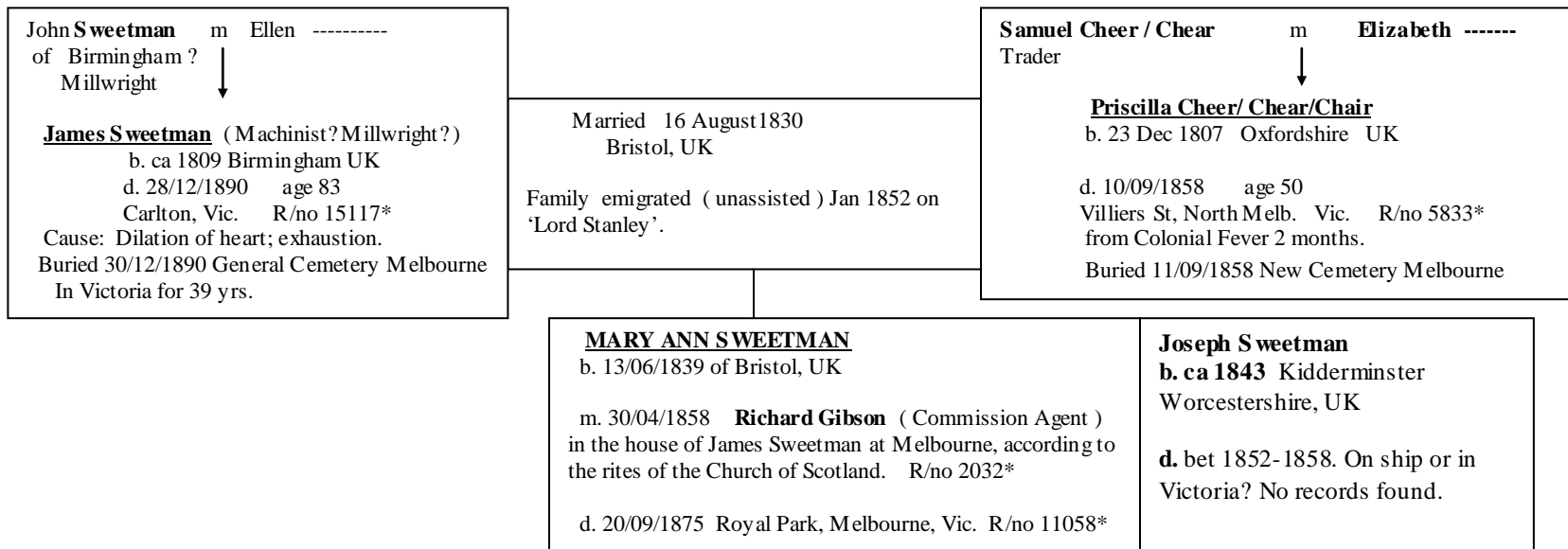

 The garden was at 'Omama' Murrumbreena 1898 - 1909, - later called 'Joyous Gard' by Dr John Springthorpe.,

Margaret is now considered a pioneer of Australian garden design.

Both pastoralists in NSW. (source Liber Melburniensis 1848-1936)

Presented two communion cups to Mauchline church in 1888.

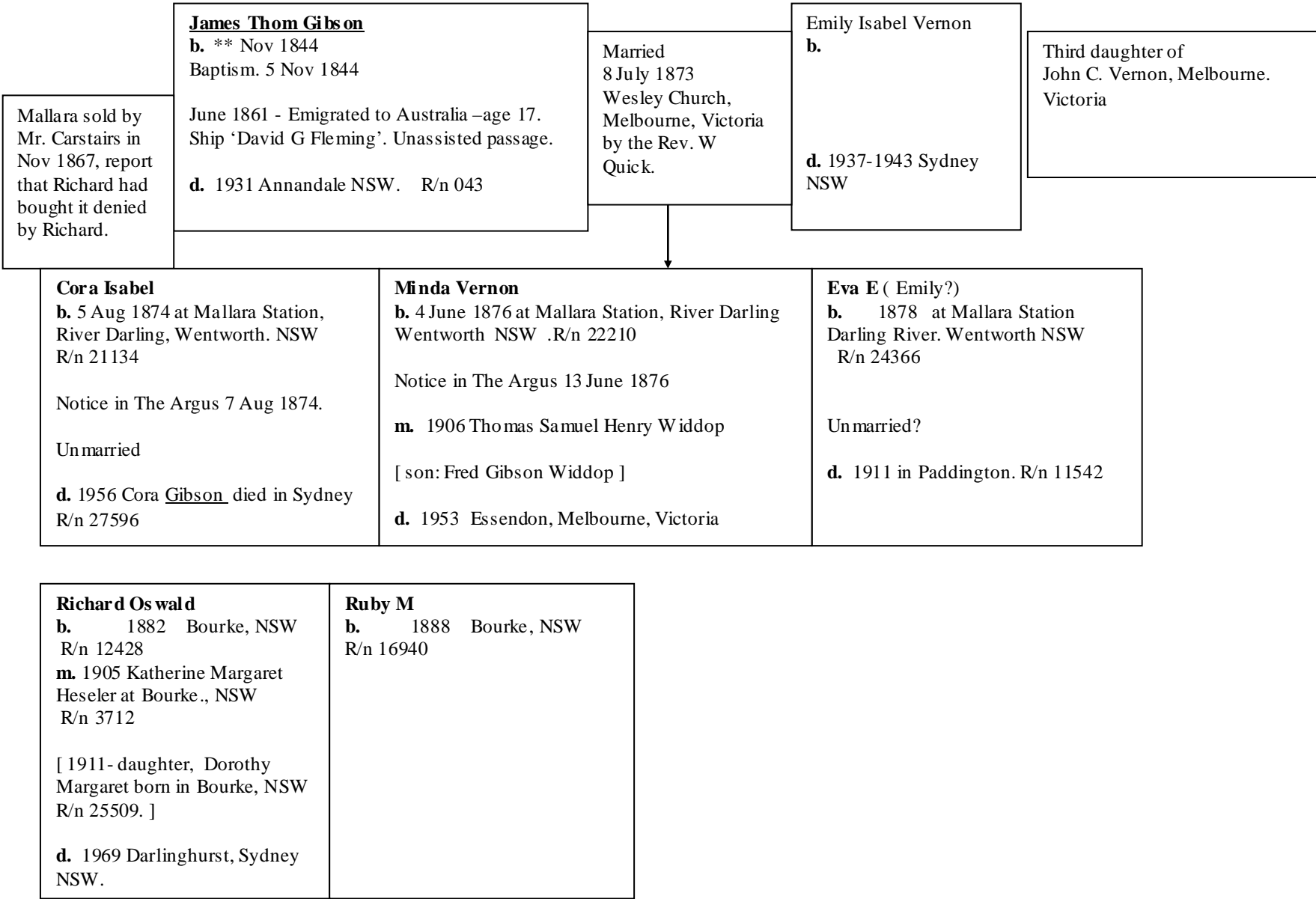
Neither had children.
